The children's ministry of North Pointe aims to teach the story of Jesus to the preschoolers and children that come into our program. Teaching key principles of the Christian life and making them relevant to our kids is an important and worthwhile investment. To do so, the kids ministry requires many adults to serve in the ministry's various programs. There are many "jobs" and "tasks" that can be done by many different people. Many of our service areas require different lengths of service and often a rotation schedule is used--from weekly assignments to monthly and longer. Our children's ministry utilizes loving and committed volunteers in Sunday School, Kids Worship, Extended Session in our preschool area, Kids Beach Club and TeamKids.



The needs of student ministry can be expressed simply in the need for faithful mentors. A mentor is not someone who lives a perfect life. A mentor is someone who worships a perfect God and leads by example for our students in how to pursue and prioritize Him. Our mentors serve in the student ministry by teaching Sunday morning lessons, leading dis-
